Entrepreneurial Skills Pass

1) Entrepreneurial experience, a perfect preparation for working life

At the end of the programme they present a report and accounts to their shareholders.

The programme is supported by volunteer advisers from the business world who are available to guide and mentor the students. Throughout the learning path, students can assess their competences and prepare for the final exam.
